4-H County Communications Night

Country Ham Project Youth: this is a requirement of your project, so please call the office with the title of your speech before the deadline.

Youth, ages 9-18, are invited to compete in the county level speech and demonstration Contest on April 29 at the Meade County Extension Office. Check in begins at 5:30 pm. Contest begins at 6:00 pm.

This contest teaches youth the parts of a good speech or demonstration, how to write the text, effective delivery techniques and gives lots of opportunities to practice in front of others. Category champions will go on to represent Meade County at the West 5/West 6 Area competition in Grayson County on May 6.

SIGN UP: Call the office (270-422-4958) to register (be prepared to give the title of your speech/demonstration and your birthdate). **DEADLINE to register is: Monday, April 21.**



Speech Categories (by age): No visual aids are allowed for speeches (costumes are considered a visual aid). No dramatic readings, dramatic monologues or recitation of poems is allowed. Speech must be youth's own original work. **NOTE: "4-H age" is how old youth was on January 1, 2025**.

Juniors (ages 9 - 13): The 4-H'er may have assistance in writing and preparation based on age level. <u>Speeches must be 3 to 5 minutes long.</u>

Seniors (ages 14 - 18): Because this is an educational learning experience, the Senior 4-H'er is expected to choose a topic, research and write their own speech. A participant may have assistance with practicing the speech. <u>Speeches must be 5 to 7 minutes long</u>.

Demonstrations: Junior/Senior categories are same as speeches but broken into subject specific categories (i.e. foods, wood working, etc.). The time limit for demonstrations (juniors and seniors) will be 5 to15 minutes. <u>Call the office to receive a complete list of demonstration</u> <u>categories for the 2025 program year.</u>





AT THE SENIOR LEVEL, the 4-H'er is expected to demonstrate original work. The internet may be used as a reference source but NOT as a source for non-original speech or demonstration materials.

If you haven't already been working on projects for the county fair... NOW is the time to begin planning for your 2025 4-H Fair entries. The 4-H Fair Catalog is now available in hard copy format. It will be available online soon – we will let you know when that status changes. To receive a copy of the 4-H fair catalog, stop by the Extension Office to pick up a copy. Our **4-H entry date is still to be decided.** Entries will be taken at the 4-H/FFA exhibit building at the fairgrounds. 
